In order to effectively combat the epidemic of homelessness affecting more than 70,000 people in New York City and to meet the needs of our neighbors across the New York metro area, New York City Rescue Mission and Goodwill Rescue Mission have joined forces with The Bowery Mission. Leveraging more than 400 years of combined service, three historic organizations have become one to reimagine the fight against poverty and homelessness. From nine campuses in New York City, Newark and the Poconos Region of Pennsylvania.

Compassionate Care

Compassionate Care invites guests to **Choose Help**. Through hospitality, food, safe shelter, clothing, showers, and medical care—tangible expressions of God's love—we meet the immediate needs of each person who walks through our Red Doors.

Each year, we serve:

-  653,500 hot meals
-  167,300 nights of safe shelter
-  46,400 articles of clothing
-  1,300 onsite medical, dental and optometry exams







Residential & Community Programs

Residential & Community Programs help clients **Make Progress**. Clients access comprehensive services for physical, emotional, psychological, and spiritual healing — all in the context of a safe, supportive community.

Each year, we serve:

-  354 adults in residential recovery programs
-  800 people at the Community Hope Resource Center with access to free educational, medical, legal, housing and vocational services
-  97 adults who obtained employment
-  100 adults who obtained housing
-  280 referrals to outside services
-  51 graduates—men and women who met all indicators of future success

Transitional Housing & Alumni Programs

Transitional Housing & Alumni Programs inspire graduates to **Sustain & Grow**. Through transitional housing and ongoing access to services, graduates are equipped to find success beyond the walls of our programs.

Each year, we serve:

-  178 currently active alumni
-  78% of alumni are working
-  82% of alumni have sustainable housing
-  83% of alumni have enough income to meet basic needs
-  87% of alumni have maintained sobriety



Children's Programs

Children's Programs empower children to **Thrive & Succeed**. Year-round opportunities for enrichment culminate in an unforgettable weeklong experience at our 200-acre camp in the Poconos Region of Pennsylvania, where they encounter the love of their Creator.

Each year, we serve:

-  284 children & youth in year-round enrichment programs
-  900 children & youth at our summer camp in the Poconos Region of Pennsylvania
-  91 youth active in formal leadership training
-  88 youth paired with adult mentors
-  14 summer camp staff who are former campers
