MEMBER GOALS

What does a \$1,000 net impact look like?

You will be supported by the Associate Board team and The Bowery Mission Development Staff to help you reach your goal. Your fundraising plan will be personalized to your network, and you'll have multiple opportunities to exceed this goal.

You can easily achieve this goal in three ways:

PERSONAL DONATIONS

Dollars donated personally by you; we ask that this be at least half of your \$1,000 commitment.

LEVERAGED DONATIONS

Dollars donated to The Bowery Mission because of your connection; includes corporate matching gifts and donations, friends and family event tickets or auction purchases, donations, and event sponsorships.

GOODS & SERVICES

Items or services that The Bowery Mission requires to keep raising money; includes auction items, vendor services, pro-bono services and more.
