The Bowery Mission has served generations of New Yorkers experiencing homelessness, hunger and poverty since the 1870s. Every year, we continue this legacy, driven by our belief that hope is rebuilt and lives are transformed when we love well.



### Homelessness in NYC

Even before the onset of COVID-19, homelessness in New York City was skyrocketing — with nearly 80,000 people in need of housing, the highest level since the Great Depression. Now, the pandemic has led to an even greater spike in homelessness and food insecurity. Food insecurity has nearly doubled, impacting an estimated 1 in 4 New Yorkers. Over a million New Yorkers have lost employment income and hundreds of thousands face pending eviction.

### 1. Compassionate Care

Compassionate Care invites guests to Choose Help. Through hospitality, food, safe shelter, clothing, showers and medical care — tangible expressions of God's love — we meet the immediate needs of each person who walks through our Red Doors.

Last year, we served:

-  429,500 meals
-  104,000 nights of shelter
-  27,600 articles of clothing
-  67,500 emergency showers
-  1,500 onsite medical and optometry exams











## 2. Residential & Community Programs

Residential & Community Programs help clients **Make Progress**. Clients access comprehensive services for physical, emotional, psychological and spiritual healing — all in the context of a safe, supportive community.

Last year, we served:

-  751 adults who completed a needs assessment with a clinical ambassador
-  321 adults in residential programs
-  91 adults who obtained employment
-  74 adults who obtained secure housing

## 3. Transitional Housing & Alumni Programs

Transitional Housing & Alumni Programs inspire graduates to **Sustain & Grow**. Through transitional housing and ongoing access to services, graduates are equipped to find success beyond the walls of our programs.

Alumni continue to engage with The Bowery Mission community through reunion events and volunteer opportunities. They also have ongoing access to vocational services, and provide support and encouragement to others through sharing their own stories at chapel services, graduation ceremonies, events and more.



## 4. Children's Programs

Children's Programs empower children to **Thrive & Succeed**. Year-round opportunities for enrichment culminate in an unforgettable weeklong experience at our 200-acre camp in the Poconos Region of Pennsylvania, where they build lasting, healthy relationships with counselors and peers.

Last year, we served:

-  225 children & youth in year-round enrichment programs
-  300 families through ongoing engagement
-  82 youth active in formal leadership training
-  51 unique campers who participated in 1:1 online tutoring
-  41 volunteer adult mentors paired with youth
